WHO MAY APPLY: U.S. CITIZENS AND NATIONALS.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED: Candidates must have 52 weeks of specialized experience. Specialized experience is defined as experience in cartography or in a related field such as photogrammetry or geodesy, where the work required similar knowledge and skills. A candidate must have had 52 weeks of qualifying specialized experience equivalent to the grade 05 level for the grade 06 to meet the qualification requirements in the Federal service. Qualifications will be determined by the information provided in your Official Personnel Folder (OPF) or application (OF-612)/resume.

EDUCATION SUBSTITUTION: One-half year (13 quarters or 9 semester hours) of graduate education or an internship meets the required experience only in those instances where it is directly related to the work of the position. Non-NPC Applicants: Transcript must be submitted with application by the closing date.

DUTIES: This position is located in the BAS Processing Section, Geography Branch (GB), National Processing Center (NPC) and will be assigned to one of the units in the section. The branch is responsible for preparing a wide variety of geographic coding allocation, feature and address update, and boundary delineation operations required in tabulation, evaluation, and publication of data for the Census Bureau's varied censuses and surveys.
